EXPLOSION AT SEA.

Reported From Pacific. Extensive **Submarine Disturbance**. SYUIC1SY, May S.

An extensive **submarine disturbance** is believed to have occurred near Admiralty Island*, in the Mandated Territory, to the North of New Guinea.

A radio message received to-night in Sydney by the Amalgamated Wireless of Australia Ltd., from Manus, the principal island of the Krout), stated that a heavy south-easterly storm, followed by a violent explosion from morning. At the Rivalow observatory, the seleniograph recorded a 7.5- magnitude **disturbance**, about 2,300 miles distant. PRINCE HUMPHREY.

Alleged Mistake.

SYDNEY, May 9. The man who held the position of Registrar at Woodlands Stud before the war was dispersed, supporting the view that in the registration of horses the Prince Humphrey and Cragman pedigrees were confused.
