

## AN EARTHQUAKE SHOCK AT SEA.

NEW-ORLEANS, Aug. 13.—The steamship New-Orleans, of the Cromwell Line, from New-York, arrived last night. Capt. Halsey reports that at 8 A. M. on the 8th inst., when in the latitude of Charleston, she experienced a severe shock of an earthquake. There were three or four unusually high seas and a terrific jar throughout the ship; at the time she was in 18 fathoms of water. An hour before this occurred one of the firemen, becoming deranged, jumped overboard and was drowned.
