

THROWN UP BY THE SEA.

SAN ANAFRE, Cal., April 19.—A peculiar phenomenon has occurred here. Quantities of submarine vegetation have been thrown up on the beach, covering it for 16 miles. There are also a large number of dead fishes on the shore, among them whales, sharks, and sea turtles. One whale measures 55 feet and a turtle is 10 feet in length. Hundreds of persons are here to witness the extraordinary scenes. The phenomena is believed to have been caused by a submarine eruption.
