

Felt an Earthquake at Sea.

HAVRE, Aug. 6.—The British steamer Homer, from Santos, reports that while speaking the German bark Christine, from San Francisco for Queenstown, on July 20, in latitude 39 degrees north, longitude 36 degrees west, a severe earthquake shock was felt. The shock, which caused the ship's compasses to revolve violently, lasted forty seconds. The Christine signaled that she, also, felt the disturbance.
