

EARTHQUAKE AT SEA.

Steamer Albingia Reports Severe Shock Yesterday Near Jamaica.

KINGSTON, Oct. 31.—The Captain of the German steamer Albingia, from New York Oct. 13, which arrived here to-day, reports that at 1 o'clock this morning, while the vessel was approaching the southern coast of Jamaica, a severe earthquake was experienced. The sea was greatly agitated and the ship rocked violently. Much alarm was caused among the passengers.

The seismograph here has not recorded any recent shock.
