
FELT EARTHQUAKE AT SEA.

**Scared Crews Thought Their Ships
Had Run Aground.**

SAN FRANCISCO, Feb. 1.—Two craft arriving here today reported having felt Tuesday morning an earthquake some miles off the northern California coast.

The steam schooner **Hartwood** was twenty miles off **Trinidad Head** when **Captain Johanson**, who was on the bridge, thought the vessel had grounded, and the crew rushed on deck expecting trouble. A sounding was taken before it was certain the vessel was not grounded.

Captain Wallstedt of the cod fisher **Golden State** also reported that he believed the vessel aground when the shock was felt off **Point Arena**.
