

East Coast Area Feels Sea Quake

BOSTON. — (INS) — A supposed underseas earthquake or landslide somewhere off the north Atlantic coast Thursday—so severe that it was felt in cities and towns of Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire and the Quebec province of Canada—was recorded as far west as Cleveland, Ohio.

The Atlantic ocean quake or undersea landslide started at 6:55:24 a. m. and lasted several minutes, but did no damage except to rattle windows in the Boston area.

Dr. L. D. Leet, director of the seismographic station of Harvard university observatory at Harvard, Mass., said the shock was so near and severe that it wiped out the record.

Boston residents of apartment buildings said they were shaken by the tremors.
